

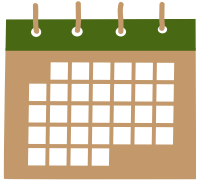
Thanks for Volunteering Us!

Learn more about how to prepare your group for a tree planting with CanopyBloomington.



Attire

Wear clothes that you are okay with getting a little dirty and closed toed shoes. A lot of our volunteers wear long pants and a T-shirt or sweatshirt depending on the weather. Make sure to check the forecast to see if you need a raincoat. We will provide gloves and tools to all volunteers.



Hours

We schedule our plantings from 9-1 but they may end earlier depending on the number of volunteers. Volunteers can start arriving at 8:30am.



What to expect

Volunteers can expect to 1) learn how to plant and mulch a tree, 2) dig a few holes in the ground about 2 feet deep, 3) Mulch the newly planted trees, 4) Water the trees



Location

Volunteers will all meet at one location to sign forms and watch the demonstration. The forester will send out the meet-up location and any additional instructions a week before planting.



Ideal number of volunteers

We hope to have about 2-3 volunteers per tree totaling around 15-20 volunteers.
